They are names

we cannot count.



Here are some uncountable nouns.



bread



cheese



chocolate



cereal



tea



milk



ketchup



coffee

Uncountable nouns can only be singular.

The have no plural form.

- you cannot count uncountable nouns
- never use a/an or numbers before them
- never add -s to an uncountable noun
- always use a singular verb with them
- use *how much* to ask questions with uncountable nouns

Make them countable!

With uncountable nouns we can use words like bottle, bowl, carton.
